OUR GUIDANCE FOR EXHIBITORS

YOUR SAFETY IS OUR MAIN PRIORITY

Together with you, we are looking forward to a successful Techno-Classica Essen 2022 and are implementing a range of measures to ensure a safe fair experience for everyone. To this end, we have developed an extensive hygiene and protection concept that we constantly adapt to any changes in the Coronavirus Protection Ordinance of the State of North Rhine-Westphalia. This enables us to run Techno-Classica Essen 2022 responsibly and with a minimum of fuss. This brochure provides an overview of our hygiene concept so you can see at a glance what protective measures must be implemented before and during your fair participation and how you can ensure maximum safety at your stand.

You will see that effective infection protection can be easily integrated into your fair activities.

We appreciate your collaboration to ensure a safe and successful event for our exhibitors, for visitors and for you and your employees.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Exhibitors, stand construction companies, service partners and other people involved in the Techno-Classica Essen 2022 on the exhibitor side will only be granted entry with proof of vaccination, testing or recovery (3G), as outlined below:

- You have been vaccinated against COVID-19 in accordance with section 2 of the Coronavirus Protection Ordinance and can provide valid documentary proof of this at the entrance to the trade fair site on the day you are attending an event (Persons who have been vaccinated and have recovered are also considered to be fully immunised.);
- Persons who have recovered from COVID-19 infection and present as evidence a positive PCR test (or other nucleic acid detection) that is at least 28 days and no more than 90 days old (from day 91 onwards the status ceases if no vaccination has taken place), and
- You can provide proof of a negative test in accordance with section 2 of the Coronavirus Protection Ordinance at the entrance to the trade fair site on the day you are attending an event. The rapid antigen test has a validity of 24 hours, the PCR test has a validity of 48 hours.
- Children and adolescents under the age of 18 are treated the same as immunised persons if they take part in the school tests (proof of school ID).

You, your employees and your service partners must have the requisite proof (3G: vaccination, test, recovery) in a digital format that is suitable for scanning with the CovPassCheck app. You will need to present your photo ID (ID card or driving licence) to verify your identity.

STAND CONSTRUCTION AND DISMANTLING

Surgical face masks must be worn during construction and dismantling.

STAND DESIGN

We recommend taking suitable precautions to prevent droplet or smear infection. These include:

- Installing transparent screens at reception desks and other interaction points
- Providing hand sanitiser
- Installing generously sized meeting rooms and hospitality areas.
- Taking measures to avoid the formation of queues,
- the arrangement of exhibits in such a way that there are no accumulations of trade fair participants. Sufficiently dimensioned lounge or visitor areas can be a solution here.

ACCESS AND ADMISSION

Exhibitor passes and passes for service staff will be scanned contact-free at the entrance.

Cashless and contact-free payment (e.g. of parking tickets or in restaurants) is possible.

DURING THE EVENT

Surgical face masks must be worn in the exhibition halls.

Surgical face masks are not required in the following areas:

- in catering facilities such as restaurants or Coffee Points

Stand parties, receptions or similar must be approved separately by the event organiser.

HYGIENE AND PROTECTION MEASURES

We recommend that you provide hand sanitiser at your stand. In addition, we have installed a large number of hand sanitiser dispensers and hand-washing facilities throughout the site.

Please ensure that contact surfaces such as counters, tables and door handles are cleaned regularly.

You should observe coughing and sneezing etiquette and keep your distance from other people.

If you have typical symptoms, you will not be admitted to the fair. **Exhibitors who do not observe the obligation to wear the mouth-nose covering must be excluded from the fair.** (Exception: If persons cannot wear mouth-nose covering for medical reasons).

CATERING | RESTAURANTS

All our restaurants apply the general rules for the catering sector that you are familiar with. These include being able to remove your surgical face mask once you are seated and registering your contact details.

Catering staff at your stand must always wear a surgical face mask.

Please choose food and drink that are individually packaged or can be easily portioned for serving.

You may not provide self-service food and drink.

Our catering partners will be happy to design an individual catering concept to meet your needs. If you choose not to work with one of the Messe Essen catering partners, your service provider must prove compliance with the Coronavirus Protection Ordinance of the State of North Rhine-Westphalia.
